



# SOUL OF THINGS Simple I Jacket Paper Prototype

This paper pattern has been developed by fashion designer/educator Lilia Yip, especially for their *Soul of Things* exhibition at the Fashion on Display Gallery, Singapore.

Follow the instructions provided to create your own mini 3D paper jacket prototype.

You can draw, colour and decorate your jacket. Customise it and make it yours!

cutting line

-----folding line

If you are making this at home, print this out on an A4 sheet of paper.

1. Cut out the jacket shape along the outer cutting line.
2. Snip the 4 diagonal lines under the arm.
3. Cut down the centre front of the jacket and around the neck
4. Cut partway down the two lines on the front right and left, stop when you get to the dotted line. Fold twice along the front dotted lines on each side of the centre front.
4. Turn over the garment so that the inside of the jacket faces you.
5. Fold along the diagonal dotted lines on all 4 sides of the garment.
6. Turn over the garment so that the outside of the jacket faces you.
7. Fold the jacket in half, along the dotted lines at the shoulder.
8. Tie the front jacket ties in to a paper knot. VOILA!
